## New Bylaws – Member Summary Handout

### What Are These Changes?

The Association has updated and modernized its Bylaws to improve clarity, transparency, and alignment with Texas law. This is a full rewrite, not a partial amendment.

### What's Improved?

- Clear definitions and organization
- Easier-to-understand language
- Modern meeting and voting options
- Stronger election rules and safeguards
- Clearer Board and committee roles

### What Hasn't Changed?

- Members still control core governance decisions
- Property rights and deed restrictions remain unchanged
- The Board remains unpaid and accountable volunteer Members

### What About Board Power?

- The Board can update operational Bylaws
- Members must still approve changes to Board structure and terms
- This allows flexibility while preserving Member protections

### Why This Matters

- Easier participation
- Fewer disputes caused by unclear language
- Faster response to community needs
- A governing document built for long-term use

### Next Steps

- A written ballot will be mailed to all Members, with a 30-day reply period
- A simple majority vote of the Members responding will decide
- The new Bylaws will be filed in the County property records and the Association will operate under them going forward
